UPDATE OF THE PRESENT POLICY

WHO ARE THE DATA CONTROLLERS OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

INTER PARTNER ASSISTANCE, NV whose registered office is at Boulevard du Régent 7, B-1000 Brussels, registered with the Banque-Carrefour des Entreprises under no. 0415.591.055, acts as an independent data controller of your personal data (it means that it determines the purposes and means of the processing of your personal data).

The independent data controller is referred to in this policy as "**AXA Partners**" or "**Data Controller**" or "**we**" or "**us**".

WHAT ARE THE CATEGORIES OF THE COOKIES DROPPED WHILE YOU ARE BROWSING OUR WEBSITE AND WHAT ARE THEIR PURPOSES?

FUNCTIONAL AND TECHNICAL COOKIES (STRICTLY NECESSARY COOKIES)

These cookies are **necessary** for the **website to function** and **cannot be switched off** in our systems. They are usually **only set** in **response to actions** made by you to **request services**, such as setting your **privacy preferences, logging in** or **filling in forms**. You can set your **browser to block** or **alert you** about these cookies, but some parts of the website will not then work.

Internal Cookie	This cookie is set by the cookie compliance solution from OneTrust. It stores information about the categories of cookies the site uses and whether visitors have given or withdrawn consent for the use of each category. This enables site owners to prevent cookies in each category from being set in the users browser, when consent is not given. The cookie has a normal lifespan of one year, so that returning visitors to the site will have their preferences remembered. It contains no information that can identify the site visitor. AUDIENCE MEASUREMENT COOKIES

These cookies allow us to **count visits** and **traffic sources** so we can **measure** and **improve** the **performance** of our website. They enable us to know **which pages** are the **most** and **least popular** and see **how** visitors **move around** the website. All information these cookies collect is aggregated. If you do not allow these cookies we will not know when you have visited our website and will not be able to monitor its performance.

HOW TO ACCEPT OR REFUSE COOKIES?

A cookie banner pops up as from your first visit of the website « fe.axa-assistance.be ». This cookie banner enables you to either:

- **Accept all optional cookies** which are not strictly necessary for the proper functioning of the website, or
- **Refuse all cookies** that are not strictly necessary to the proper functioning of the website,
- **Access the Cookie Preference Center to set up your choices** in terms of consent (meaning that you may select individually cookies you accept to drop while browsing event though they are not essential to the proper functioning of the website).

We will store your preferences, whether consent or refusal of cookies, for **12 months**. Once this period expired, the cookie banner will pop up gain for you to set up your preferences again. You can adjust the cookie settings at any time via the preference center in the footer.



IS COOKIE DEPOSIT MANDATORY?

The **strictly necessary** or **optional** character of each category of cookies is indicated at the very moment you are asked to grant (or deny) consent, either via the cookie banner at the occasion of your first visit to our website, or through the Cookie preference center.

The Cookie Preference Center' remains accessible **at any time in the footer** of the website but also by clicking '**Personalize my choices**' in the **cookie banner**.
